Hello again,

Let me begin by wishing you all belated happy new year.

So here's February, the month of romance as Valentine's day creeps up, although not being a leap, year, any ladies wanting to



propose may have to wait a while yet [if anyone remembers that tradition]. It's also the month where we run our marriage preparation session for all the couples getting married in our churches this year, so if you are a praying person, do take a moment to hold up in prayer those couples making this enormous commitment.

Love, of course, is a funny thing. People often tell me they don't believe in God because they only believe in what their senses show them. So I ask; 'do you believe in love?' You can't measure love, can't weight it, see it, or put a blob of it in a test tube, and yet we all know love is as real as daylight [as God is too]. Defining exactly what it is, of course, is much harder. We know when we feel loved, and feel love for others, but how reliable are our feelings? For me, true love must be worked out by actions, giving of ourselves by choice for the good of the beloved. The feelings in any relationship come and go with the pressures of life, but my experience is that if you keep on 'doing the loving' by decision and action the feelings always come back.

And thinking of love; about the hardest thing I do is helping families through bereavement as they arrange funerals for a loved one; and I'm so conscious of so many of you who may be reading this that you are coming to terms with enormous loss in your life. There is no easy answer to this. We have a hope of redemption and reunion in eternity, but that is no substitute on earth for the person missing from our lives. Why this, and where was God? We all ask it at some point. Well, I believe that to love is to be vulnerable to pain; the potential of love lost or a death of one we love. And in this, God is no different from us. If we think of God at all we may imagine him as some big powerful fuzzy force in the heavens, but God is firstly a person. And as a person, who loves us, he suffers with us everything that we suffer as any parent suffers over the pain of their child. I do believe in a resurrection life; that all will be well. But also that God is with us now, feeling our pain, weeping with those who weep as he also laughs with those who laugh. God doesn't take people away from us, death does that, and God, in Jesus, has beaten death both for himself and for all of us, so death does not get the last word, Jesus does; and his word to us is life, with him, forever more, because love, is stronger than even death.



Hatherleigh Carnival has sadly lost "One of it's own"

Andrew Fishleigh was involved from birth until death. On his first float he was a "Jack in the Box" how appropriate! He was then on numerous floats throughout his childhood with the Balsdon's & Aunty Pam. In 1997 as a 6 year old, he was an attendant for Katie (Agnew) Bennett on the Queens float, a picture of complete innocence.

Once old enough, he pulled the Tar Barrels when able (if you know, you know lol!). He also loved the Friday Undercover Carnival Klub, otherwise affectionately known as the FU##'ers, carrying on the tradition of dressing up on the Friday night to generally take the mickey out of some poor soul from the local area.

From 2010 to 2024 a new generation of the Jolly Boys had evolved of which Fish was a mainstay. An eclectic bunch of mis-fits that would meet up just two or three weeks before carnival to build a float. This was always a special time where friendships grew over the years. Generally Fish was left to put the side rails on & painting, until one year where he unsuccessfully tried his hand out at the electrics which led to a fair bit of ribbing from the boys over the years. He fulfilled many roles on the floats throughout the years. Who can forget the Chilean Miners in 2010?

Unfortunately in 2013 he didn't make the procession after partying too hard & was last seen wobbling home in just his Union Jack underpants. He did however get to play Brian May again the year after lockdown in 2021 on Hatherleigh Housewives Unlocked performing the guitar solo for "I want to Break Free "Other floats were the Royal Floatilla, Oktoberfest (the year after the Committee banned alcohol on the floats lol!), The US Election, Playboy where he starred as Hugh Hefner, Hatherleigh Airways following the demise of Thomas Cook, Hatherleigh "Village" People & Hatherleigh Community Gym.

Mary Poppins in 2015 really stood out for two reasons. Firstly the impromptu dance off between the two Mary Poppins, Fish & 7 year old Abi. Secondly, Fish was suspended by a harness about 10 foot in the air behind the trailer on two of the rustiest scaffold poles that Cobby had welded to the trailer frame. Following the procession, we decided to take a short cut to the Tar Barrels meet up point via the bypass, only to realise halfway down whilst doing what seemed like 50 mph that we'd forgotten to take Fish down first!

And finally, his last float ever. Hatherleigh Carnival KingAgain, how appropriate! When we stopped for the very last time ever with him outside the George, that was sooo special. I've never seen so many people join in & sing his name! So many people said" How did he make them all laugh & cry at the same time?

The best tribute ever & he loved it!

An entertainer till the end.







Curworthy Cheese and Chive Scones

After my time in "the kitchen utensil wilderness", after about a year and half of my husband saying we should have one, this dinosaur has finally circumed to the lure of the air fryer! I have never been a fan of fast food so I did baulk at the idea of my husband wanting me to buy bags of supermarket chips and hash browns to "feed the beast" that now sits on the kitchen counter where my lovely old scales and brass weights used to be. I determined that this "new fangled thing" would



not lead me down the slippery slope to fast food oblivion so the first recipe I tried was this one for Cheese and Chive Scones; it works a treat, takes minutes to prepare and when they are fresh and warm you don't need anything on them as they are full of cheesy, buttery, herby loveliness.

200g plain flour, 2 heaped tsp of baking powder, 75g chopped butter from the fridge, 120g of grated mature Curworthy or similar cheese (plus a little more to sprinkle on the top), 1 tsp of made mustard mixed into 80ml of milk (plus a little milk to wash the top before sprinkling on the cheese), 1 large handful of chives chopped very finely.

Preheat your air fryer to 180 degrees

Rub the butter into the flour and baking powder then mix in the cheese and chives. Pour in the mustard and milk and then work quickly to roughly bring it all together. Don't overwork it. When you have a big ball, flatten it out so it's about 3 - 4 cm thick. Wash the circle with a little milk and sprinkle a tiny bit of cheese on top. Cut the circle into 6 slices. Arrange these in the air fryer, with a gap between each triangle. Cook for 12 minutes at 180 degrees. It didn't take long to down the first batch so next time I made a double batch and put them in the air fryer one after the other. These freeze really well and are easily reheated from frozen.






